Sunday, June 18

Deuteronomy 6:5 Love GOD, your God, with your whole heart: love him with all that's in you, love him with all you've got!

Monday, June 19

Philemon 1:25 The grace of the Lord Jesus Christ be with your spirit.

Sacred Pause: There is not a place where the grace of God is not already present. We call it prevenient grace. Grace that goes before, beside and after us all the time.

Tuesday, June 20

Numbers 6:24-26 The Lord bless you and keep you; the Lord make his face shine on you and be gracious to you; the Lord turn his face toward you and give you peace.

Sacred Pause: Receive this: The Lord bless you and keep you; the Lord make his face shine on you and be gracious to you; the Lord turn his face toward you and give you peace.

Wednesday, June 21

Psalms 34:8 Taste and see that the Lord is good; blessed is the one who takes refuge in him.

Sacred Pause: God is good all the time. Name two ways God is good to you. Look for the goodness of God in others. How does looking for goodness change your view of others?

Thursday, June 22

Luke 6:27-28 But to you who are listening I say: Love your enemies, do good to those who hate you, bless those who curse you, pray for those who mistreat you.

Sacred Pause: God's blessings fall on the just and the unjust alike. This truth can help you bless even those who curse you. Bless everyone and you will feel more blessed.

Friday, June 23

1 Peter 3:9 Do not repay evil with evil or insult with insult. On the contrary, repay evil with blessing, because to this you were called so that you may inherit a blessing.

Sacred Pause: According to our scripture, you are blessed to be a blessing to others. How might you bless those around you today? Be creative! Be generous! Be blessed!

Saturday, June 24

2 Corinthians 9:8 God has the power to provide you with more than enough of every kind of grace. That way, you will have everything you need always and in everything to provide more than enough for every kind of good work.

Sacred Pause: There is enough! You have everything you need to be a blessing to others. It might be a kind word. It might be a hug. It might be a smile. There is enough!
